#### Changes Coming to Bill Pay

We're making improvements to your TexasBank online banking experience! Starting August 1, you'll notice more transparency in how your Bill Pay transactions are processed.

Here's what's changing:

#### **Check Payment Processing**

Check Payments will not be electronically debited and then a check issued and mailed on your behalf. A draft check will be sent directly from your account.

#### When Funds Leave Your Account

If the payment is electronic, the funds will be withdrawn from your account immediately —just like before.

If the payment is made by check, the funds will stay in your account until the merchant deposits and processes the check—just like writing a paper check yourself.

This update ensures your money isn't pulled until your merchant actually gets paid. It's all part of our commitment to giving you more control and visibility over your finances.
